This school wide raffle celebrates students who display our values and meet expectations. Our winners for week 7 were **William, Laughlin and Trystin**.

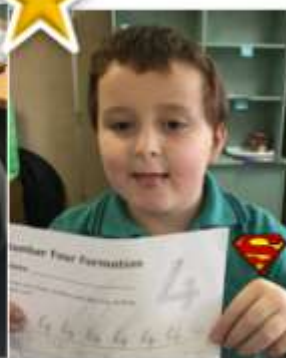

I like swimming on Mondays. I like Home Eco and I like eating the food we cook. From Jasmine

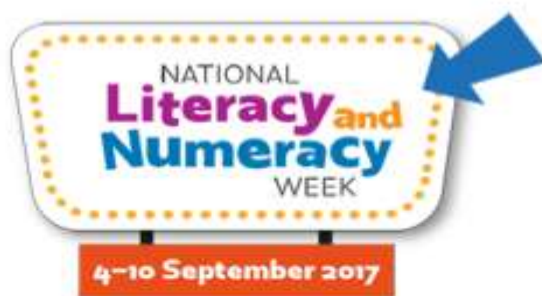
I like recess and lunchtimes so I can play with my friends. I like Home Eco and Swimming. I like Music and Dance, especially with my friends. From Leila.

Building Early speaking and listening skills

Speaking and listening is the key foundation for learning.

All primary schools and special schools in your local area have organised a 'Let's Chat' program for parents and their three and four year old children. This program is free of charge and will benefit every child.

This four week program will support you to increase your confidence to turn shared book reading and everyday routines into opportunities to build early literacy skills with your young children.

In addition to the program being free of charge, there will also be child-minding in the first part of each session at every school and special school setting, as you learn new skills to get your child chatting.

The program commences in Term Three 2017 and will operate in 14 primary schools and 3 special school settings.

If the time and date of your closest primary school is not suitable, you can register at any other school. If you miss a session, you can register at any other school to catch up on that session. All schools will be implementing the same program using the same types of books.

Registration details are listed for every school. If you are interested, feel free to sign up with a friend or friends from your local kindergarten.

At the end of each session, you will receive a free children's book to enjoy with your child.
