## Principal's Report

Dear students and families,  
Naranga School uses School-Wide Positive Behaviour Support in order to promote positive behaviours and teach students about whole school expectations. Our key expectations are BE SAFE, BE RESPECTFUL, BE RESPONSIBLE and BE A LEARNER. You may have seen these printed on our flags at the front of the school. In every part of the school, staff use this language to create consistency and surround students with positive expectations. Each week we feature one of our school expectations in our Spotlight Sessions. During Circle Time the class discusses the expectation that is in the Spotlight and learns more about how to display that expectation in all parts of the day. This week the Spotlight has been on TRYING YOUR BEST. We have used the concept of GROWTH MINDSET to reinforce the importance of trying your best in everything you do. With a growth mindset, students learn to take on challenges, accept that errors are part of learning and have a belief that with hard work they can improve their skills.

Each week we reward students who demonstrate the Naranga expectations. At Assembly we recognize our older students with Senior Commendations. All senior students who receive a commendation are invited to a pizza lunch in the last week of term hosted by school leadership. Younger students are rewarded with tickets that make them eligible for the raffle that is held at every Assembly. In addition, many classes have their own star charts, sticker charts or other systems in place that reinforce the classroom expectations.
